Epoxy Marble-Finish Dining Table Customer Care, Design Approval & Expectations Guide

Your table is a handcrafted resin artwork designed for functional everyday use. Unlike natural marble, granite or manufactured quartz, epoxy is a polymer surface and requires appropriate care. Natural handmade variations are part of the character of each piece.

Consideration	What to Know & How to Care for It
Heat	High heat can soften, discolor, dull or leave impressions in epoxy. Always use trivets or heat-resistant pads. Never place hot cookware, baking dishes or heated appliances directly on the tabletop.
Scratches	Glossy epoxy can develop fine scratches from normal use. Use placemats, coasters and felt pads, and avoid dragging objects across the surface.
White Color & UV Exposure	All epoxy systems can experience some color shift with age and UV exposure. UV-resistant materials help reduce this but do not make epoxy completely UV-proof. Avoid prolonged direct sunlight, particularly on brilliant or diamond-white finishes.
Stains & Spills	Wipe spills promptly. Coffee, tea, red wine, turmeric, food coloring and other strongly pigmented materials may discolor the surface if left for extended periods.
Micro-Scratches & Gloss	Routine dining, cleaning and handling can create fine surface marks or subtle changes in gloss over time. This is normal wear and does not necessarily indicate a defect.
Handmade Variation	Marble veins, metallic movement, cells, color transitions and pattern placement are created by hand. No two tables will be identical. Samples, photographs and digital renderings are design references rather than exact replicas.
Small Handmade Imperfections	Minor bubbles, pinholes, dust nibs or subtle surface variations can occasionally occur in handcrafted resin work. Small variations that do not affect function or overall appearance are part of the handmade nature of the piece.
Cleaning Products	Use a soft microfiber cloth with mild soap and water. Avoid abrasive pads or powders, acetone, harsh solvents, strong degreasers and aggressive chemical cleaners.
Impact & Chipping	Epoxy is durable but not indestructible. Heavy or sharp objects can chip or damage the surface or edges if dropped.
Weight & Loading	Do not sit, stand or climb on the tabletop. Avoid excessive concentrated loads, particularly near unsupported edges.
Indoor Use	Unless specifically commissioned and constructed for outdoor use, the table should be treated as an indoor furniture piece.
Future Repairs	Many scratches and wear marks can potentially be polished, refinished or recoated. Repairs may improve the appearance substantially, but a repaired area cannot always be guaranteed to be completely invisible.

Important Notice for White & Diamond-White Finishes

Color & UV Notice: Epoxy resin is a handcrafted polymer material. While professional UV-resistant materials may be used, subtle color changes can naturally occur over time. To help preserve the original white finish, avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight and excessive heat.

Handcrafted Design Variation

Each HuesbyLats epoxy table is individually poured by hand. Marble veining, metallic movement, color placement, cells and pattern will naturally vary from samples, photographs and digital renderings. Resin continues to flow, move and blend during the pouring and curing process. The **approved color palette will remain consistent**, but the exact pattern, flow and placement may vary slightly and cannot be duplicated exactly. These artistic variations are part of the handcrafted character of the piece and are not considered defects.

14 x 20 Inch Design Sample & Approval

Before production of the dining table begins, HuesbyLats can create a 14 x 20 inch resin tray as a physical design sample.

The sample is intended to demonstrate the selected colors, overall finish, metallic accents and artistic direction. Because resin art has a natural flowing character, the **colors will remain consistent with the approved sample, but the exact marble pattern and movement on the full-size dining table will vary.** The final table cannot be an exact enlargement or duplicate of the sample because every pour is individually handmade.

Sample Fee: \$200, including shipping. The sample fee is due once the design direction and colors are agreed upon and before the sample tray is produced.

If the customer proceeds with the dining table: the full \$200 sample fee will be credited toward the final table payment.

If the customer chooses not to proceed: the customer may keep the 14 x 20 inch sample tray. The \$200 sample fee is non-refundable.

Recommended Everyday Care

Use placemats, coasters, trivets and felt pads; wipe spills promptly; clean with mild soap, water and a soft microfiber cloth; protect the table from prolonged direct sunlight; avoid dragging heavy or rough objects; and never place very hot cookware directly on the surface.
